**Seashore Creature Program for Kids!  
At the Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum  
Monday, July 13 at 11 a.m.**

**June 29, 2009 (Provincetown)** On July 13 at 11:00 a.m. the Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum (PMPM) will offer a one hour educational program on Seashore Creatures conducted by educators from the Cape Cod Cooperative Extension Service. Children will learn about sea life found at local beaches through investigating live and/or preserved crabs, spider crabs, horseshoe crabs, shrimp, sea stars, bivalves and small fish. They can make a shell magnet to take home with them.

The one hour program is for children ages 8 and up, maximum of 15 children per program. Free with admission to the PMPM. Families may wish to plan to spend extra time visiting the museum, climbing the Pilgrim Monument and/or enjoying a picnic lunch on the grounds after the program.
